Conditions:

- 1. The school shall be registered under the Child Rights Education Act, 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act, 1983 and the rules framed there under, and the accreditation shall be renewed up to the registered class.
- 2. The school shall function under the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act 1983 and the Child Rights Education Act 2009.

- 3. Child Rights Education Act 2009 to reserve 25% seats for weaker section children under the rules framed there under. The Government has the authority to enroll the reserved seats under RTE for the schools covered by RTE. (Government has framed rules to facilitate the enrollment of children in neighboring schools where their parents live, according to which, if there are government or government-funded educational institutions, children will be enrolled in that school] Otherwise, private schools should enroll children enrolled by the government and allow them to continue their education up to the primary level. Allowing these children to continue their studies without any discrimination.
- 4. Fees of children enrolled under RTE Rules as described in Condition: 3 will be released by the Government as per rules. Hence it has stopped charging any fees from these children.
- 5. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any kind of capitation fee and voluntary donations from the parents either at the time of enrollment or thereafter.
- 6. The school / management body shall publish the information of the fee collected from the parents of the children in their school as tuition fee as per State Government Notification No: ED:31:PGC:2019, dated:27.07.2019 on the departmental website and on the school notice board. No fee shall be charged in excess of the prescribed fee.
- 7. The School / Governing Body shall enroll the students within the period fixed by the Govt.
- 8. The School / Governing Body cannot refuse enrollment against the following points.
 - (i) Due to lack of proof of age.
- (ii) On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language.
- (iii) If admission is sought after extended period of admission.
- 9. Carrying out all safety measures as per RTE Act and Rules, Karnataka Education Act and Rules. [Fire safety and building safety certificate from concerned authorities and children's learning safety as per K.S.C.P.C.R and N.C.P.C.R!
- 10. School / Management
- (i) No admitted child shall be retained in any class or expelled from the school until he completes primary education and secondary education in the school.
- (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental abuse.
- (ii) No child shall be required to pass any board examination till completion of primary education.
- (iv) Every child who completes primary education is issued a certificate as prescribed under RTE Rule 21 and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
- (v) As per the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules the school shall also admit children with special needs / special children.
- (vi) Teachers appointed under RTE Act and Rules and Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders Primary and High School teachers should possess the minimum qualifications as prescribed.
- (vii) The salary and allowances payable to the teachers and the terms of service and allowances shall be as prescribed by the State Government, and the salaries to be paid to the teachers through Government Notification [Prospective Fund (P)] and payable bank and other emoluments. and subject to Employee State Insurance (ESI).
- (vii) Teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section 24(1) of the Act and the RTE Act and Rules and Rule 170 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage themselves in private tuitions for supervisory considerations.

- 11. Adherence to academic State Curriculum and State Text Books incorporated by Shall.
- 12. For a moment, if the sidi is hardened, he will perform the intoxicating treatment. Appointing departmental staff as prescribed in Kanakottaka Rakshakan Kaya and Rules.
- 13. School buildings and other basic facilities associated with the school should not be given over to any commercial activities or political and non-educational activities during the day or night.
- 14. The school shall not be run for the benefit of any person or group or association.
- 15. Get the school audited by a Chartered Accountant, copy to the Deputy Director / Field Education Officer by the end of June every year.
- 16. As per Government Notification [Kannada Language Policy 2016) the school shall follow Bhava Policy.
- 17. Governing body and teachers to act as per RTE Act and Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
- 18. The School / Governing Body shall strictly follow the rules and directives of the Government and the Department.
- 19. Mandatory uploading of school information in S.A.T.S. by the end of March every year.
- 20. Violation of the above conditions will result in the cancellation of the recognition of the school as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
- 21. After the school accreditation process is completed, the entire document information in the application submitted online by the governing body will be made available for public viewing on the departmental website.
- 22. Violation of the above conditions will result in the cancellation of the recognition of the school as per the rules framed under the RTE Act 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act 1983.
